Choraku-kan is a house built by the businessman Kichibei Murai (known as the "tobacco king") in the Meiji period, and it is located in the south corner of Maruyama Park. Designed by the American engineer T. M. Gardiner, and constructed by Man-nosuke Shimizu, it was completed in 1909, and now functions as a cafe-restaurant.
